William Wilson, Jr., DDS, MS started his dental career in 1989 as a dental assistant and dental laboratory technician in the US Navy. He was commissioned as a US Navy Dental Officer in 1996 and enrolled as a student at the West Virginia University School of Dentistry. Following graduation from dental school, Dr. Wilson completed a one-year Advanced Education in General Dentistry (AEGD) residency at Parris Island, SC. Prior to his retirement from the Navy, he served as the Department Chairman and Program Director for Maxillofacial Prosthetics at the Naval Postgraduate Dental

School, and currently maintains an active private practice limited to the specialty of prosthodontics, in Fairfax, VA.
