Dr. Frank Tuminelli Honored with Educator of the Year Award by the American College of Prosthodontists Prominent New York Prosthodontist Honored by Peers

CHICAGO – Frank J. Tuminelli, DMD, FACP, was honored with the Educator of the Year Award by the American College of Prosthodontists (ACP) at the Annual Awards & President's Dinner during the 47th Annual Session of the ACP held in San Francisco from Nov. 1-4, 2017.

The Educator of the Year Award recognizes an individual with exceptional skills as a dental educator and outstanding achievements and contributions in academic and professional dentistry. Dr. Tuminelli received this year's award for work as the Program Director of Advanced Prosthodontics at the Manhattan Veterans Administration, New York Campus and as a clinical assistant professor in the Department of Dental Medicine at the Hofstra Northwell School of Medicine.

"Education is the single best vehicle to change the world for the better," said Dr. Frank Tuminelli. "Being the recipient of this award is one of the most humbling honors one could receive. On a personal note, being recognized by my peers with this award validates a commitment I have had since the inception of my professional career."

Dr. Tuminelli is the treasurer of the American College of Prosthodontists Education Foundation (ACPEF), a past president and Fellow of the ACP, and a past president of the Greater New York Academy of Prosthodontics. In addition to his teaching roles, Dr. Tuminelli maintains a private practice limited to prosthodontics on Long Island. He also lectures nationally and is frequently seen in social and traditional media raising awareness of prosthodontics.

Dr. Tuminelli received his dental degree from Fairleigh Dickenson University School of Dental Medicine. Following a one-year General Practice residency at Long Island Jewish Medical Center, he returned to complete his specialty training and received his Certificate in Prosthodontics. He previously led the graduate program for New York Hospital Queens and was a team dentist for the New York Islanders Hockey Club.
