The American College of Prosthodontists Installs Dr. Nadim Z. Baba as President-Elect *Officers Installed During* 47^{th} *Annual Session of the American College of Prosthodontists*



CHICAGO – <u>Nadim Z. Baba, DMD, MSD, FACP</u>, has been installed as President-Elect of the American College of Prosthodontists (ACP) for a one-year term that will ascend to the role of President in late 2018. Dr. Baba was sworn in during the 47th Annual Session of the ACP held in San Francisco, Nov. 1-4, 2017.

"I am very grateful to the members of the College for the trust they put in me. I will do everything I can to be an outstanding representative of prosthodontics around the nation and around the world," said Dr. Baba. "The ACP is a great, strong organization comprised of a remarkable group of professionals. It is a great honor to serve and be a part of the College."

Within the ACP, Dr. Baba is a Fellow and sits on several committees and task forces. Prior to serving as President-Elect, Dr. Baba was the Vice President for one year, Region 5 (Pacific) Director for four years and President of the California section for

three years. Dr. Baba also served as the Vice-Chair of the ACPEF Annual Appeal Committee for two years, which helped start a course on 'Transitioning into Private Practice' for ACP members. The course was offered in 2015 and 2016.

Outside of the ACP, Dr. Baba has given over 100 national and international presentations, and regularly reviews and edits industry publications like the *Journal of Prosthodontics, Journal of Prosthetics Dentistry,* and *Journal of Dental Traumatology,* where he also serves as an associate editor. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics and maintains a part-time private practice limited to prosthodontics and implant dentistry in Glendale, California. Dr. Baba also serves as a professor in the Advanced Education Program in Prosthodontics at Loma Linda University, School of Dentistry.

Dr. Baba received his DMD degree from the University of Montréal. He completed a Certificate in Advanced Graduate Studies in Prosthodontics and a master's degree in Restorative Sciences in Prosthodontics from Boston University Goldman School of Dental Medicine.

With their advanced training, prosthodontists are able to help patients with implants, dentures and veneers, all the way to a full mouth and jaw reconstruction.
